# Online Bidding

## No Bidding Permissions:

# Online Bidding

Once you have logged in and the lot you are registered for is being offered, you will see the following:

# Online Bidding

When a bid is placed:

- When a bid is placed, you will see that your bid has been submitted and is waiting for the auctioneer to accept it.

If your bid is unsuccessful (e.g. the auctioneer accepts a bid from another bidder), the button will prompt you to place a bid at the next asking price.

# Online Bidding

- You will be notified that your bid was successful and that you are now the highest bidder.


If you are outbid, the button will prompt you to bid again with the new asking price. You will also see here where the bid has come from.

# Online Bidding

When you successfully win the lot:

- If your offer is accepted as the winning bid, the button will be replaced by a message reading 'Sold to You'.  
You will also receive an email confirming your successful purchase.
